

On December 1, 2024, the eagerly awaited ceramics exhibition Clay Affection, Pottery Expressions will open its doors, inviting art lovers on a journey into the heart of ceramic artistry. Featuring the remarkable works of Master Potter Peter Low Hwee Min and 45 of his talented protégés from Taiwan, Singapore, and Malaysia, this exhibition transcends the boundaries of art, showcasing the passion, heritage, and intimate connection between artists and clay.

Master Potter Peter Low, born in 1943 in the serene town of Muar, Johor, Malaysia, is a name synonymous with excellence in ceramics. A visionary artist and teacher, Master Potter Peter Low artistic odyssey began at the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts in Singapore, where he mastered Western painting and sculpture. His journey led him to the UK, where he delved into the world of ceramics at the West Surrey College of Art and Design, graduating with first-class honors. Returning to Malaysia in 1974, he established his own pottery studio, planting seeds that would grow into a thriving legacy of ceramic artistry across Southeast Asia. Through his work and teaching in Singapore and Taiwan, he has become a guiding light in the ceramics community.

Master Potter Peter Low artistry is a harmonious blend of Eastern and Western influences, a testament to his ability to balance tradition with innovation. His works have graced the galleries of Malaysia, Singapore, Taiwan, the Philippines, and Brunei, earning him a place among the greats. His unwavering dedication to the craft was recognized in 2009 with the Malaysia Pottery Lifetime Achievement Award, a fitting tribute to his enduring impact on the world of ceramics.

The legacy of Master Potter Peter Low extends far beyond his own creations. His students, guided by his wisdom and passion, have blossomed into accomplished ceramic artists in their own right. In Clay Affection, Pottery Expressions, these artists present over 250 masterpieces, each a reflection of their unique artistic voice. From traditional forms to bold innovations, these pieces transform humble clay into vessels of emotion, memory, and meaning.

The exhibition is a symphony of textures and forms, each work resonating with the transformative power of clay. Through their hands, artists breathe life into the raw material, molding it into expressions that speak to the depths of human experience. Visitors will witness this alchemy firsthand, exploring works that echo the "pottery expressions" born from the soul of the artist.

泥情陶意•走进陶艺灵魂的旅程

2024年12月1日,备受期待的陶艺展览《泥情陶意》即将盛大开幕,邀请艺术爱好者参与探索陶艺之心的旅程。此次展览汇聚了陶艺大师刘伟仁及其45位来自台湾、新加坡和马来西亚的才华横溢学生的杰作。这不仅是一次艺术盛宴,更是对艺术家与泥土之间深厚情感、技艺传承和创新精神的赞颂。

刘伟仁大师,1943年出生于马来西亚柔佛州麻坡市,以其卓越的陶艺成就闻名。他在新加坡南洋美术专科学校开启艺术生涯,专攻西洋画和雕塑,随后远赴英国西萨里艺术设计学院(West Surrey College of Art and Design),以一等荣誉完成陶艺专业的深造。1974年,他回到马来西亚,创办陶艺工作室,种下了陶艺传承的种子。通过在新加坡和台湾的教学与创作,他成为东南亚陶艺界的灯塔,为地区陶艺的发展作出了不可磨灭的贡献。

刘伟仁的艺术风格将东西方文化精妙融合,在传统与创新间找到了完美平衡。他的作品曾在马来西亚、新加坡、台湾、菲律宾和文莱的画廊展出,赢得广泛赞誉。2009年,他因毕生致力于陶艺而获颁马来西亚陶艺终身成就奖,彰显其深远影响。







In a sense, I am bringing past and present into conversation, into play."

The storytelling aspect captivates me, often drawing on references from the 'thingliness' we encounter in our daily lives to provoke fresh interpretations and narratives. The familiarity serves as a bridge, connecting the audience to the work on a personal and relatable level. Through this process, viewers are invited to consider the hidden stories behind everyday things.

Particularly captivating is the concept of 'animatedness', the subtle liveliness that emerges from the placement, composition, and interaction of objects with the space they occupy. This sense of motion is not always overt, but it lingers in the viewer's perception. Exploring the structural balance and arrangement of objects in the form of assemblages becomes a central focus, with attention given to material characteristics, spatial configurations, and inherent conditions. The work reflects an intricate dialogue between objects, where boundaries, both physical and conceptual, play a key role. By highlighting these boundaries, the tension or harmony that arises from the arrangement of elements within space is revealed.

As the practice evolves, the aim is to explore how objects communicate meaning and evoke emotion. Blending structural exploration with narrative building encourages viewers to reflect on their relationships with objects, space, and memory, offering a new perspective on their surroundings.


